### Installation of the Scaffold Gantry

Works will begin this Friday 13th November to install the gantry for the McAlee & Rushe welfare and site offices on Brixton Hill. Please refer to the indicative layouts above. To facilitate the works, the area outside the site hoarding along Brixton Hill will be closed for pedestrians. Pedestrians will be diverted onto a temporary walkway during this time.

The works have been approved by Transport for London (TFL) and are due to finish on Friday 20th November. The pedestrian crossing outside the site will be permanently closed. It is not expected for these works to create noise issues but we apologise in advance for any inconvenience caused.

### Thames Water

You may be aware of Thames Water carrying out leak investigation work in Hayter Road. Please be advised this is not related to the site works and if you have any queries regarding their investigation, these should be directed to Thames Water.

However, we note from the signage that the proposed date for reinstatement is the 13/11/20.
