As advised prior to the break, we are now entering into the noisiest element of our works where we will be removing the existing basement walls and slab. These works will begin w/c 11th January 2021 for a six week period.

During this time we will again work in strict accordance with the “noisy and quiet times” agreed and any mitigation techniques identified and as discussed will be fully implemented. There will be a couple of additional plant movements and machine changeovers during this period as you can appreciate, but this amount will be relatively low and will not adversely affect you.

Unfortunately, as a country we are now again entering into another lockdown and regrettably the respite provision at the Town Hall will not be available to use during this period. McAlee & Rushe will continue to work within the CLC (Construction Leadership Council) guidance version 6 and the protection of our workforce is of paramount importance in minimising the risk and spread of this infection.
