BRIXTON NEIGHBOURHOOD CONSTRUCTION FORUM (BNCF)

THE REDEVELOPMENT OF OLIVE MORRIS HOUSE IS THE FINAL PHASE IN THE 'YOUR NEW TOWN HALL' (YNTH) PROJECT, BEING DELIVERED BY MUSE DEVELOPMENTS IN PARTNERSHIP WITH LAMBETH COUNCIL.

Works are well underway to deliver 74 new homes, including 21 affordable rent and 9 intermediate homes, as well as commercial / retail space on the site of the former Olive Morris House.

Throughout the development, we will be holding regular community meetings called the 'Brixton Neighbourhood Construction Forum' (BNCF). The BNCF meetings have already been held in April and June and this flyer is your invitation to attend the next Forum in September 2020.

Due to continued Government Covid-19 restrictions on social distancing, we are having this session online again so that you can discuss the project directly with the team and learn more about the ongoing works.
